Continue to read any books and read to your family or pets



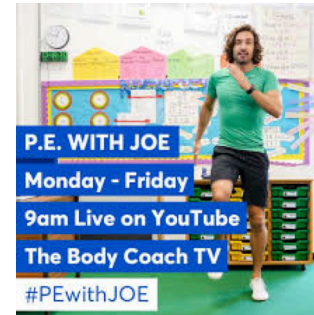
Activity 2

Activity 6

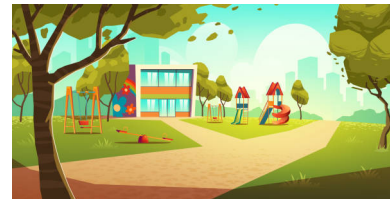
The Great Caedmon Bake off! This week's idea is Cake pop. Follow the BBC link for the recipe
