I can...

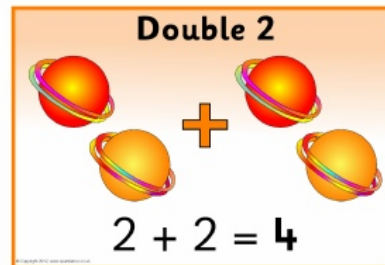
I am...

Family Activities

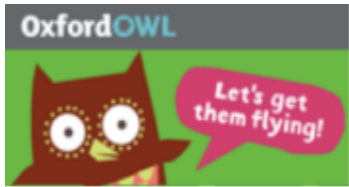
With a grown up decorate some biscuits and see if you can make some faces! Maybe your own face or a teacher's? We would love to see some pictures!
